

## GSOC CASE THROUGHPUT TO 6<sup>th</sup> September 2007

GSOC received 1136 complaints in the period 9<sup>th</sup> May to September 6<sup>th</sup> 2007 and a further 152 matters were referred to it under Section 102(1) of the Garda Síochána Act 2005 in that time. The latter are matters referred by the Garda Commissioner where it appears that the conduct of a Garda may have resulted in the death of or serious harm to a person.
