GSOC seeks witnesses to Road Traffic Incident on Dame Street, Dublin 2.

The Garda Síochána Ombudsman Commission (GSOC) has opened an investigation into the circumstances surrounding a Road Traffic Incident on Dame Street, Dublin 2 at approximately 20.30hrs., last night, Tuesday, 28th July. The incident was referred to GSOC by the Garda Commissioner under section 102(1) of the Garda Síochána Act 2005.

GSOC is seeking witnesses to the incident which involved a red 06 Toyota Corolla Garda vehicle colliding with a female pedestrian. The incident occurred at the pedestrian crossing on Dame Street, between Trinity Street and Anglesea Street.
