Update to the below:

It has been confirmed that the pedestrian involved in the road traffic incident in Clondalkin this morning, a 75 year old female, has died in hospital.

GSOC responds to referral of road traffic incident in Dublin 22

GSOC has been informed of a road traffic incident involving a marked garda vehicle, where a pedestrian was injured, in Clondalkin, Dublin 22. A team of investigators has been sent to the scene.

The incident was referred to GSOC at approximately 11.30am, having occurred shortly before that. The female pedestrian has been transferred to Tallaght Hospital by ambulance with serious injuries.

Traffic diversions are in place at the scene of the incident – the junction of Fonthill Road and St. John’s Road – and may remain in place for several hours.

An update will be given with further details as soon as they become available.

The incident was referred to the Garda Ombudsman for independent investigation in accordance with Section 102 of the Garda Síochána Act.
